



Filming Notification: "PUNCH" at White Bay Power Station

Dear Resident/Building Owner/Business Owner,

As a valued member of the local community, we're writing to inform you about upcoming filming activity for the feature film "PUNCH," produced by Punch Prod Au Pty Ltd, which is scheduled to take place within White Bay Power Station. The following outlines dates and approximate times related to our filming activities:

Key Dates:

Bump In:	6:30am – 6:30pm	Monday 28 th July – Friday 1 st August Monday 4 th August – Saturday 9 th August Monday 11 th August – Thursday 14 th August Monday 18 th August (6:30am – 11:00pm)*
Rehearsals:	07:00am - 7:30pm	Sunday 16 th August
Filming:	3:00pm – 5:00am	Tuesday 19 th August – Friday 22 nd August* (Filming into Saturday AM)
Bump Out	6:30am - 6:30pm	Saturday 23 rd August (7:00am – 6:30pm)* Sunday 24 th August – Tuesday 26 th August

In the event of bad weather, filming will instead take place on Monday 18th August and/or Saturday 23rd August.

Traffic Control & Equipment Vehicle Parking:

To ensure the safety of both residents and our production crew, authorised traffic controllers will implement a brief hold-and-release system to facilitate truck turns at the intersection of Robert and Mullens Streets in Rozelle.

To minimise disruption to the neighbourhood, our main truck base and crew parking will be located off-site. Crew members will then be transported via shuttle buses to the filming location. Our crew will be instructed to maintain minimal noise levels between 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM to respect the quiet nature of your neighbourhood.

Special effects, including atmospheric smoke, will be used throughout filming. NSW Emergency Services will be notified about these activities.
