As a valued member of the local community, we're writing to inform you about upcoming filming activity for the feature film "PUNCH," produced by Punch Prod Au Pty Ltd, which is scheduled to take place within White Bay Power Station. The following outlines dates and approximate times related to our filming activities:

**Site Preparation :** Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> September – Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> October 2025. **Filming Dates :** Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> October – Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> October 2025

**Bump out :** Friday 17<sup>th</sup> October – Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2025.

Most of our filming will take place between the hours of 0500 (5:00am) – 2300 (11:00pm). Additional filming is scheduled to occur onsite during the day on Tuesday 14th & Wednesday 15th October 2025, times to be confirmed.

## Special effects, including atmospheric smoke, will be used throughout filming.

To facilitate truck movement during peak traffic periods through White Bay Power Station we will implement temporary traffic control at the intersection of Mullens and Robert Streets in Rozelle.
