FILMING NOTIFICATION – WHITE BAY POWER STATION

Dear Resident / Business Owner,

Servo Productions 37 Pty Ltd is currently in production on a feature film that will be filming scenes at **White Bay Power Station, Robert Street** between **Tuesday 6 October and Friday 23 October 2026**. Filming hours will vary depending on the requirements of each day's schedule but are expected to fall between approximately 7am and 10pm.

All of the filming will take place within White Bay Power Station itself. However, on certain days, temporary traffic and footpath calming (slow signage for cars and bicycles) may be required around the site (on Robert St) to ensure the safety of cast, crew and members of the public. Where these measures are required, council approval will be requested and surrounding properties will receive a direct notification at least three days in advance. We understand the importance of maintaining access to your home and/or business.

As part of the production, professionally managed prop firearms will be used on set. These are film props and will be handled under strict safety procedures. During filming, you may occasionally hear **simulated action sound effects designed to resemble firearm sounds for cinematic purposes**. These sounds are entirely fictional and form part of the film production. No live ammunition will be used and no real firearms will be discharged. The relevant local authorities, including Police and Fire Services, will be notified of the filming activities.

The production will also involve several other film-related effects and activities, including controlled smoke/haze, American-style emergency vehicles and choreographed stunt sequences. While most filming will take place inside the venue, we anticipate approximately **2–3 days of exterior filming** around the outside of the buildings. The number of cast and background performers (extras) will vary throughout the production, with some scenes requiring larger numbers on certain days.
