

**Event & Road Closure Notification:
Biennale of Sydney
"Art After Dark: Last Light"
Friday 12 June 2026**

Dear Resident/Building Owner/Business Owner,

As a valued member of the local community, we would like to inform you of some important information regarding an upcoming event at White Bay Power Station (WBPS).

The Biennale of Sydney exhibition at **White Bay Power Station** will close on 14 June 2026. As part of the closing weekend celebrations, the Biennale of Sydney is holding an event on Friday 12 June. This is a free, community event for 3000 people.

This will involve a closure of Robert St, subject to Inner West Council approvals and the Biennale of Sydney event site will be extended to include the roadway. The event will include live music performances, food trucks & bars and access to the main exhibition at White Bay Power Station. A number of management plans including noise, traffic and security will be implemented. Staff and security will also be monitoring the area regularly to keep disturbances to a minimum.

Special arrangements:

- **Robert St will be closed between Mullens St & Port Access Rd, from 5pm Friday 12 June to 4am Saturday 13 June 2026.**
- **Detour routes will be in place around Roberts Street.**
- **Changed parking restrictions will be in place on Robert St between Mullens St & Port Access Rd from 5:30am Friday 12 June.** Signage will be in place to indicate changed conditions and a tow-away zone will be in effect for non-compliant vehicles.
- A Traffic Management Plan will be implemented to help minimise impacts to regular traffic and ensure safe pedestrian and traffic movements.
- A taxi & rideshare drop off & pick up zone will be operating on Robert St eastbound between Crescent St & Mullens St, from 7-11:30pm
- Additional buses will run between QVB and White Bay Power Station to reduce the impact on local traffic.
- A temporary outdoor stage will include amplified sound from 7-11pm, with technical checks from 3pm onwards. Noise restrictions and monitoring will be in place to ensure sound levels do not exceed permitted limits.
- NSW Police will be in attendance.
