White Bay Power Station – Victoria Rd/Robert St West Shared Path Widening Construction

Dear Resident/Building Owner/Business Owner,

We are writing to inform you that Ford Civil will be commencing construction works on the corner of Victoria Rd and Robert St as of 15/09/2026 to upgrade the existing footpath pavement.

The upgrade will generally consist of site establishment, vegetation clearing on the site, associated structural and civil works to widen the footpath itself, and the installation of new planter beds. During the initial stages of the works the main disturbances caused will be impacts to vehicle traffic from truck movements coming in and out of the site, and noise associated with the works. Within this initial stage, all construction will primarily be taking place behind the secure fencing of the White Bay Power Station.

Normal working hours of the project will be:

- 7am to 5pm Mon – Fri and
- 7am to 1pm Saturdays.

Once the initial stage of work is completed, minor alterations to pedestrian walkways will take place to permit Ford Civil to demolish and replace the existing footpath. During this later stage of the project, out of hours works will be required to complete, and pedestrian management measures will be in place to assist and ensure minimal impacts are experienced
